

Both forms can be found on the Dash General Info Page and the Boat Numbers - Flight and Check In Info page.


Flights






Check in boat will be staged just outside the tires for the entry into Callville Bay

Day One Weigh In




On the docks by the store; covered area

Bring your limit up to the scale and dump your limit in sink one.







Opening comments, National Anthem, launch per draw, idle out, single file past my boat (US Flag) for launch video


All boats exit to the right of tires regardless of direction of travel

Do not get on plane until beyond the no wake buoy



Miscellaneous Information

- **Live Stream:** See website for page to share it with family and friends.
 - Live feed for Desert Dash IV, both the weigh in stage, and live leader board, will be online on 16-17 March at 2:30PM each day. If live feed is not present during this time, indicates a stable connection was not available. Weigh in will still be recorded and posted later that day on the website.
- Rules: Please ensure you review all rules posted at the site. I would like to highlight a few here.
 - Any team(s) that arrives past 6AM (designated close time of AM check in) Team(s) must standby at the designated boat check area for day one. Once the TD has launched all team's, he will proceed to the boat check location and complete the AM check in process for those teams. At that time, said team(s) will obtain a boat inspection and be released for launch. Any team that falls into this rule will retain their assigned boat number and check in time as published on their team slip, regardless of time loss fishing.
 - AM Check In Absences The AM check in is tracked by the sign in roster. Any team that does not attend the scheduled AM check in (4AM-6AM), fails to abide by rule 4a above, launches and proceeds on the event waters with their flight, will be DQ for the event.
 - No team may weigh a dead fish for their Big fish and/or Big SM. The fish may still be weighed as part of their limit but will be penalized 2 oz. (0.12 lbs.). Teams may weigh a big fish (LM) and a big SM to compete in both those options. Big Fish and Big SM winnings will be split 50/50 with team member regardless of who catches the fish.
 - In the event there is an option for the smallest 5 fish limit each day, the following rule applies. No team will qualify for this bonus if they check in a dead fish. All 5 fish must be alive.
- **Raffle and Awards Process:** If receiving anything via raffle or awards, afterwards, you will be asked to see Jason at his station, so he can obtain some info from you if required.
- Accountability: If you choose to leave early, please text both the director and assistant director. Likewise, if you come in at your scheduled time, but will not be going to weigh in, please still check in with the check in boat, and advise you are loading up. The check in official will radio in that you are checked in.
